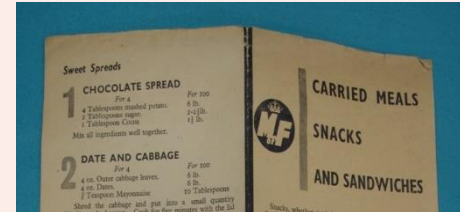




As we get ready for the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of VE Day celebrations why not try out this wartime chocolate spread recipe! Perfect as icing on a cake or on a lovely piece of toast.

## You will need...

- Cocoa powder -1 or 2 tablespoons
- Sugar – 2 tablespoons
- Mashed potato – 4 tablespoons
- Mixing bowl
- Spoon
- Potato peeler
- Potato masher



## Step One

Get an adult to help you wash, peel, chop and boil potatoes. Use the potato masher to mash the potatoes until smooth (if you want to add in butter or milk as a VE Day treat you can!)



## Step Two

Once your mashed potato has cooled a little, scoop it into the mixing bowl and add in both the sugar and the cocoa powder.



## Step Three

Mix! Keep mixing until smooth and all the ingredients are blended.



## Step Four

That's it all done! Now to taste and enjoy your alternative chocolate spread. Perfect as icing on top of a celebration cake or to make a super chocolatey toasted sandwich.



## Step Five

If you've any left, cover it up and store in the fridge. Eat within a couple of days whilst it's still fresh.
