

Victorian Toy Cup 'n' Ball

Please guide the children in your class in making this traditional Victorian Toy.

(If you don't have plain paper cups to hand, you could use the cone template that accompanies the puppet craft and make a cone instead. The cone would need to be printed on card rather than paper to be strong enough to be used for this craft.

If you don't have tin foil, you can use paper scrunched up with a bit of tape to keep its shape.)

Each child will need...

Plain paper cup String (approx. 30-40cm) Tinfoil

To share...
Felt tip pens
Scissors
Sticky tape

Step One

Decorate your paper cup in bright colours using felt tip pens.



Step Two

Using sticky tape, attach one end of the string to the inside of the cup and the other to the centre of the tinfoil.



Step Three

Scrunch up the tinfoil around the string to make a ball. Now see if you can catch the ball inside the cup!!
