



Follow the instructions below to create your wishing star decoration. When you are finished you can hang it on your Christmas tree!

You will need...

Scissors
Glue Stick
String or ribbon
Star template (see following pages, or you can draw your own)
Pencils or pens
Cardboard (any scrap cardboard will work, in this example we use a cereal box)

If you like you can also use:

Leftover wrapping paper or tin foil
Hole Punch

Step One

Cut out your star template. Place it onto your cardboard, and draw around it. Cut out the star shape.

Step Two

Decorate your cardboard star. You could decorate it with pens/pencils. Or you could stick leftover wrapping paper onto it, or some tinfoil.

Step Three

Cut out the heart. On your heart, write a wish for 2021.

Step Four

Ask a grown up to punch a hole in the star using a hole punch. Or if you don't have a hole punch at home, ask a grown up to very carefully poke a hole in the cardboard using the tip of a ballpoint pen, or sharp pencil.

Step Five

Tie some string or ribbon to your decoration.
